

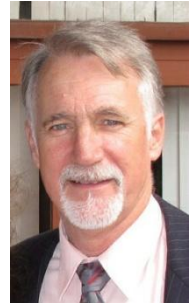

APRIL 20, 2019 MEETING

Daniel Ratelle will conduct SDCRS at our next regular meeting on April 20, 2019. A native San Diegan, he has degrees from Santa Clara University and San Diego State University, and has been the Choir Director of the 1st Unitarian Universalist Church, the Associate Conductor of the San Diego Master Chorale, the Music Director of Pacific Camerata, and a playing member of the Fayrfax Consort. He currently conducts the New City Sinfonia, and teaches Music at Mesa College.

SDCRS REGULAR MEETINGS
