This is the time to think about over-eating and under-practicing, so a good Holiday season to all of you.

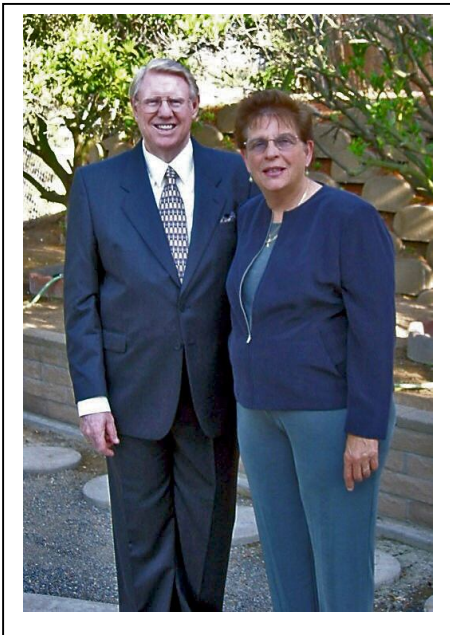
