### FEBRUARY MEETING

Dr. Marianne Pfau will be the guest conductor at our regular meeting on February 16. Dr. Pfau serves as Professor of Music History and director of the *Angelus Sacred Early Music Series* at USD. A native of Germany, she holds degrees in recorder and early music performance from Musikhochschule Hamburg, in music therapy from London's Guildhall School of Music, and the PhD in musicology from SUNY-Stony. She has published extensively on Hildegard of Bingen, edits 18<sup>th</sup>-century music for baroque oboe found in European archives, and records with *Toutes Suites*. Dr. Pfau travels widely in the US and Europe as baroque oboist and recorder soloist. Her interests as scholar-artist lie at the intersections of historical study, performance, and explorations of music for healing purposes .
