The San Diego County Recorder Society (SDCRS) is a chapter of the national [American Recorder Society](http://www.americanrecordersociety.org) (ARS), and has been in existence since 1972. A membership organization, the SDCRS supports recreational playing and public performance of recorders and other early musical instruments through monthly playing sessions, recorder instruction, workshops and pro-bono public concerts.

The leadership of the SDCRS is the SDCRS Executive Committee, which currently consists of Harvey Winokur, Vanessa Evans, Hugh Wade, Susan Neumeyer, and Maggie Fowlie. In the current 2017-18 season, the intention of the Executive Committee is to have our SDCRS operate in much the same manner as in the past. We will continue to have regular monthly meetings, guest conductors, an annual workshop with a professional conductor, refreshments at regular meetings and free recorder instruction when there is sufficient interest. **Cathie Sobke**, a San Diego native, holds degrees in music composition and music theory from SDSU. She grew up playing piano, clarinet, and guitar, and was introduced to Early Music about 19 years ago. Her collection of early musical instruments includes many recorders, Renaissance flutes, Krummhorn, cornettos, lutes, Baroque guitar, viola da gamba, and harpsichord. When she isn't playing on her instruments (or playing tennis, hiking or cycling), she can be found teaching music classes at Southwestern College where she specializes in Aural Skills. She also is available for private musical instruction. Currently performing music from the Medieval, Renaissance and Baroque periods, she plays with local groups Windsor Hills Consort, The Goliards, and Duo Lonato. Cathie has previously been a guest conductor of the SDCRS many times, and she always chooses a program of various music periods and composers that are enjoyable to play, listen to, and learn from. In some cases she provides her own arrangements of music from other composers.

For the January 20 SDCRS meeting Cathie has selected multi-part music (mostly SATB) from the following composers: Arnold von Bruck, Christopher Tye, Johann Pezel, Giovanni Domenico da Nola, Ludvig von Beethoven, Robert Schumann, William Billings, and J. S. Bach. PDF files of this music will be provided as attachments to the E-mail that transmits this newsletter. Players planning to attend this meeting are urged to print out hard copy of the files they wish to play (or download to their digital device) and bring it with them to the meeting. In the interest of saving paper and costs, only a very limited amount of extra hard copy will be available at the meeting.
