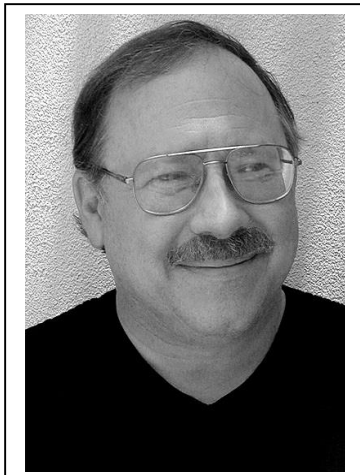

### **SDCRS GUEST CONDUCTOR FOR MARCH 21, 2015**

Composer-conductor Dr. Stephen Sturk is co-founder and Artistic Director of Cappella Gloriana, San Diego's professional chamber choir, with whom he has recorded three CD's and toured Europe twice. He is also a Founding Director of the Pacific Academy of Ecclesiastical Music (PACEM), and composer-in-residence at St. Paul's Episcopal Cathedral in San Diego. Dr. Sturk has served on the faculty of the University of San Diego, as director of the Choral Scholars Program. He has also been director of music at several San Diego-area churches.

Dr. Sturk was educated at North Central College in Naperville, Illinois (B.A. in Classics), San Diego State University (M.A. in Music History and Literature), and North Dakota State University (Doctor of Musical Arts in Choral Conducting). In 2008 North Central College, Dr. Sturk's alma mater, honored his achievements as a composer by awarding him the college's prestigious Fine Arts Medal.

### ***NEW CITY SINFONIA CONCERT***

The San Diego New City Sinfonia will present "An Evening of Mozart" concert on Friday, March 20 at 7:30P in the Sanctuary of the First Unitarian Universalist Church located in the Hillcrest area of San Diego at 4190 Front St. across the street from the UCSD Medical Center. Admission is free and free on-street parking is available after 7:00P. This all-Mozart concert will feature the Piano Concerto No. 24 in C Minor, with New York pianist Dan Franklin Smith. Also on the program will be the Divertimento No. 11 in D Major for stings, the Serenade No. 11 in Eb Major for winds and horns, the Presto from the Haffner Symphony, and the Overture to "Idomeneo", considered Mozart's first mature opera. The New City Sinfonia is sponsored by the North City Continuing Education Center, and continues its 28-year tradition of presenting free concerts to the San Diego community.
