The San Diego County Recorder Society (SDCRS) is a chapter of the national [American Recorder Society](#), and has been in existence since 1972. A membership organization, the SDCRS supports recreational playing and public performance of recorders and other early music instruments through monthly play sessions, recorder instruction, workshops and pro-bono public concerts.

The SDCRS has operated in the past with leadership delegated formally to a President, Vice President, Treasurer, Newsletter Editor, Refreshments Coordinator, and Web Master. Since the succession to these offices was not completed formally at the last SDCRS season's final meeting, the current and future leadership of the SDCRS will be in the form of an SDCRS Executive Committee, currently consisting of Harvey Winokur, Vanessa Evans, Hugh Wade, Susan Neumeyer, and Maggie Fowlie. The intention of the Executive Committee is to have our SDCRS operate in much the same manner as in the past. We will continue to have regular monthly meetings, guest conductors, refreshments at regular meetings and free recorder instruction when there is sufficient interest. We have scheduled a SDCRS workshop on October 22, 2016 (keep that date open). We're pleased that Steven Hendricks is again a guest conductor of the SDCRS this year. Steve is a household name in early music. He says that he is a musician whenever possible, specializing in the music of the Renaissance. He plays a number of period instruments, including recorders, crumhorns, rackets, alto sackbut, shawms, viola da gamba, and lute. He has put together over a dozen books of early music, and publishes an extensive collection of his arrangements on the Internet.
