### MAY 18, 2019 MEETING

The guest conductor at our May meeting will be Ramon Negrón Pérez. Born and raised in Puerto Rico, Ramon Negrón began his musical career at the age of nine. He graduated cum laude with his bachelor of music in viola performance from the Puerto Rico Conservatory of Music.

Currently an adjunct faculty member in the Department of Music at the University of San Diego, Mr. Negrón formerly served as a faculty member at the Conservatory of Music of Puerto Rico and the School of Fine Arts in Carolina, Puerto Rico. He is also a former conductor of the Overture Strings of the San Diego Youth Symphony and Conservatory, where he collaborated as a community artist teacher of the Opus Project, inspired by the success of the El Sistema movement in Venezuela.

Mr. Negrón has been a member of the Puerto Rico Symphony Orchestra, has performed often as a soloist and at numerous festivals throughout the world, and has shared the stage with many nationally and internationally acclaimed musicians. In addition, Mr. Negrón has served as principal viola of many orchestras. He currently conducts and performs with the San Diego Kensington Baroque Orchestra.
