NOVEMBER 16 MEETING

ULLA SINZ will conduct the November 16 meeting of SDCRS. She was born and raised in Germany, and began recorder studies at the age of seven with Renate Stoltenberg at the Institute of Music Leverkusen near Cologne. In 1980 she won third prize in the Young Musicians Competition (Jugend Musiziert). Her musical training continued at the University of the Virgin Islands where she studied Applied Reeds, and at the New England Conservatory of Music where she studied Classical Guitar. Since immigrating to the United States in 1986, Ulla maintains a semiprofessional status as a featured soloist. Ulla currently performs with San Diego based groups such as Windsor Hills and Trio Lonato, both Baroque ensembles, and Kensington Baroque Orchestra. On Saturday, Nov 23 she will perform locally in a recital with Dolce Dolore—see more below.
