Summer's gone, but the SDCRS has not. The next meeting of the SDCRS 2017-18 season will be on Saturday, October 21, at Clairemont Lutheran Church. The SDCRS Executive Committee hopes that all of you have had a relaxing, enjoyable summer break, but it is now time to make beautiful recorder music.

The San Diego County Recorder Society (SDCRS) is a chapter of the national [American Recorder Society](http://www.americanrecordersociety.org) (ARS), and has been in existence since 1972. A membership organization, the SDCRS supports recreational playing and public performance of recorders and other early musical instruments through monthly playing sessions, recorder instruction, workshops and pro-bono public concerts.

The leadership of the SDCRS is the SDCRS Executive Committee, which currently consists of Harvey Winokur, Vanessa Evans, Hugh Wade, Susan Neumeyer, and Maggie Fowlie. In the current 2017-18 season, the intention of the Executive Committee is to have our SDCRS operate in much the same manner as in the past. We will continue to have regular monthly meetings, guest conductors, an annual workshop with a professional conductor, refreshments at regular meetings and free recorder instruction when there is sufficient interest. Listeners are always welcome at SDCRS regular meetings. GUEST CONDUCTOR FOR OCTOBER 2017 DR. PATRICK WALDERS



Dr. Patrick Walders was born in Buffalo, New York and is a conductor, baritone, counter-tenor and music pedagogue. He obtained a BME degree from State University of New York, Master of Music from Westminster Choir College, and DMA degree from the University of Maryland. He is active as a professional vocalist, music educator, church musician, clinician and conductor. Dr. Walders conducts the SDSU Aztec Concert Choir, SDSU Chamber Choir and carries a teaching load of undergraduate and graduate conducting classes, literature courses, and ear training. His research interests include Vocal Pedagogy, diction, and rehearsal techniques. For seven years he served as the Director of Choral Activities at James Madison University (JMU). At the JMU School of Music he directed the award-winning JMU Chorale and the Madison Singers, supervised three additional choirs, taught conducting classes and graduate choral literature. These choirs performed domestically and abroad. In March 2009 the JMU Chorale and Madison Singers were featured in the Kennedy Center Terrace Theater, with program highlights that included the *Ramman Magnificat* and a fully-staged production of Gian Carlo Menotti's one-act opera, *The Unicorn, Gorgon, and Manticore*. Abroad, the JMU Chorale performed Maurice Durufle's *Requiem* in London and won first prize in the Youth Choir category at the 2009 Llangollen International Music Festival in Wales. For four seasons, he was the Associate Conductor of the National Philharmonic Chorale, and Artistic Director of the National Philharmonic Singers. In 2006, he made his National Philharmonic debut conducting Handel's *Messiah*, earning critical acclaim from *The Washington Post*, and in 2007 he made his Kennedy Center debut conducting John Hilliard's *Piano Concerto No. 2*.

Dr. Walders will conduct music by Giulio Caccini, Gustav Holst, Pierre Certon, Ludovico Viadana, Claude Gervaise, and Elvis Presley. PDF files of the music are being sent as attachments to the email which transmits this newsletter. SDCRS meeting attendees are urged to print out hard copy from the files or download it to your electronic devices and bring it to the meeting. In the interest of saving paper and ink, additional hard copy of the music will be extremely limited at the meeting.
